Restaurant Operations

The Sound Café is a small local café in Seattle serving the community with the best coffee and pastries. It provides staging performances for local talent to display, while modeling as an eco-friendly restaurant.

The café is open every day from 7am to 11pm. This schedule allows the entire community to experience the café on a daily basis at any convenient time to the customers. An array of experiences can be attained by the alterations in time, season, and events in the café. Staffing consists of two different shift workers worked by a baker, cashier, and an event host when needed.

The Sound Café bakes and serves food locally grown and bought ingredients in all their menu options. The pastry amenities menu is kept seasonal to concur with the fruits and nuts regionally available by farms.

Seating availability for fixed table arrangement seats 36 customers at a time. Standing space is available outside the café by the glass façade and extra standing space is available by the ordering counter.

Entertainment displayed in the stage includes but is not limited to poetry recitals, acoustic artists, talent shows, stand-up comedy, workshops, and lectures.

The café serves as a sustainability model by following certain tasks. Waste is eliminated by not offering bottled drinks, plastic ware, or disposable material in the café. The community is encouraged to bring their own thermals/mugs, especially for beverages on the go. Thermals and mugs for sale will be provided for those seeking to follow this habit.

Purchasing from local farms reduces food transportation therefore reducing greenhouse gas emissions. The drink products provided at the cafe come from programs that promote habitat protection and organic grown methods. Recycled cardboard is used to create modulated panels hanging from ceiling.
